## House Red Wines

### Alpha Zeta Corvina 2008

Hand picked Corvina grapes are partially dried in small boxes.. The resulting wine has a deep ruby red colour, it's brimming with fruit, rich texture and length

### Yalumba Shiraz Viognier 2008

A classic Rhône blend but from the Barossa Valley. Not a heavyweight but instead note violets on the nose and blueberries on the palate.

### Teroldego Rotaliano Riserva 2006

Complex, characteristic and pleasant ripe fruit aromas with notes of prunes and blackcurrant. Well-balanced with a soft mouthfeel.

### Ribera del Duero 2007 Bodegas Briego Joven Roble

From Spain's northern plateau, Ribera de Duero is made from Tempranillo grapes as in neighbouring Rioja. An real explosion of ripe classy fruit with good tannic grip to boot

### Hawkes Bay Merlot 2005 Kim Crawford

Rich and ripe with warm ripe berry fruit flavours. Soft tannins & good length with liquorice & Spice on the finish
