Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010 Yealands Estate

Typically vibrant Marlborough sauvignon with tropical fruit and herbal nose and a clean, crisp, and mineral balance of acidity. Its slightly restrained style makes it a great food wine

Vernaccia di San Gimignano 2009 Falchini

A unique, appealing white wine from Tuscany ; zingy, apply acidity, good body and a long finish of bitter almonds

Verdicchio Classico Superiore 2009/10 Casal di Serra

A great alternative to pinot grigio which can be a touch generic at this price level. Produced in the Marche by **Umani Ronchi**, arguably the best producer in the region, this wine is dry and citrusy with pleasant yeasty notes

Cheverny 2010 Pascal Bellier

Crisp, lean but fruity Loire sauvignon from this off-beat appellation with a touch (20%) of chardonnay to soften any sharp edges. Lovely wine for fish and sea-food

Albarino Casal Caeiro 2009

Spain's most interesting – and fashionable – white grape. Stainless steel fermentation preserves the fresh and intensely fruity flavours

Thelema Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc 2008

A wine that demonstrates how south african sauvignon from a good vintage, on the right soil, has remarkable distinction with a grassy, mineral style, more european than new world

Sancerre 2010 Roland Tissier

The palate offers a cool, stylish expression of Sauvignon Blanc, with plenty of grassy bite and hints of gunflint on the finish
